Today's focus is going to be on putting the principles of the biblical text into action.

Begin by reading James 5:7-12 in its entirety.

How Does This Point Me to Christ?

Read Hebrew 12:1-3. Pastor Brolin shared that growing in hope means investing in patience and endurance. The writer of Hebrews tells us that we should endure, and that Jesus is the ultimate example of endurance.

In what area of your spiritual life have you shown a lack of endurance? How should Jesus' example of endurance change the way you live?

What Can We Do as a Congregation?

Pastor Brolin shared how our words display where we have placed our hope, and that Shiloh should be a complaint-free zone. He asked the question, "Do the words that we say about each other reflect that our hope is in the coming of the Lord?"

How can we create a complaint-free zone here at Shiloh? What could you begin doing today that could help Shiloh reach that goal?

What Can I Do Personally?

Pastor Brolin challenged us to assess if Jesus heard your personal conversations, read your social media posts, and observed your life, would your life show that your hope is in the coming of the Lord?

What are a few tangible ways that you can display your hope through patience and endurance? Are there habits that you should start or stop that would keep your hope on the coming of the Lord?
